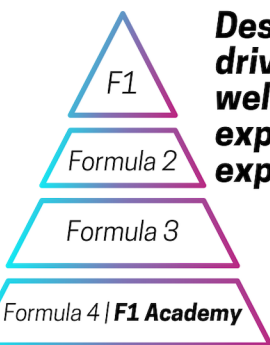

SESSIONS

Free Practice | 40 min, 1-2 per weekend, teams test and evaluate their tires and set ups

Qualifying | 30 min, drivers' fastest laps set the grid for Race 1, second fastest laps for Race 2

Races | 30 min, no required pit stops

No set schedule has been published, but assuming a Friday [FP, Quali], Saturday [Race 1], Sunday [Race 2] is fair



3.5 sets of dry tyres, single compound
2 set of wets



Chicane | two consecutive turns in opposite directions

DRS | drag reduction system, opens flap on the rear wing increasing aerodynamic performance and speed, available on select straights

Race Director | in charge of race procedures, track safety, safety cars

Safety Car | in case of racing incident, no over taking, cars reduce speed and bunch up behind the safety car

Stewards | referees, investigate racing incidents and give out penalties

Virtual Safety Car | in case of racing incident, no over taking, cars slow to safe speed, maintain time to each other

FLAGS

Green | safe track, race on

Yellow | hazard trackside, turn/sector specific

Double Yellow | hazard on track, turn/sector specific

Red | session suspended, return to pit lane

Blue | slower car must move aside
