

## **Flags**



Green: safe track, race on



Yellow: hazard trackside, turn/sector specific



Double Yellow: hazard on track, turn/sector specific



Red: session suspended, return to pit lane



Blue: slower car must move aside

**Compound** | different rubber mixes that give tires their different qualities, must use two per race

**Chicane** | two consecutive turns in opposite directions

DRS | drag reduction system, opens flap on the rear wing increasing aerodynamic performance and speed, available or select straights

Race Director | in charge of race procedures, track safety, safety cars

Safety Car | in case of racing incident, no over taking, cars reduce speed and bunch up behind the safety car

Stewards | referees, investigate racing incidents and give out penalties

Virtual Safety Car | in case of racing incident, no over taking, cars slow to safe speed, maintain time to each other
