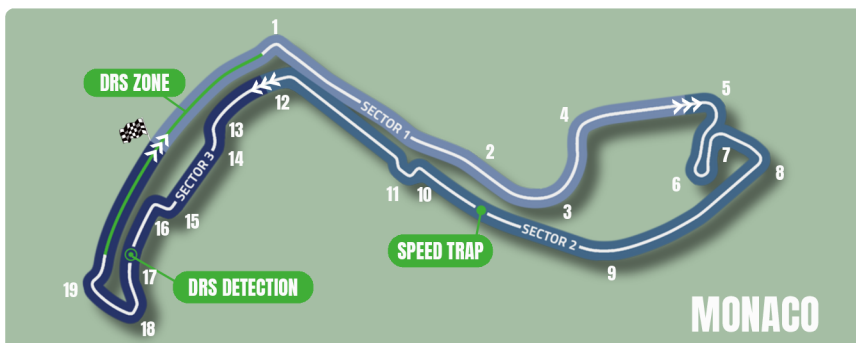

Free Practice | teams test and evaluate their tyres and set ups
Qualifying | 3 rounds, slowest 5 don't advance, sets starting lineups, shorter sessions for sprint qualifying

COMPOUND | different rubber mixes that give tyres their different qualities, must use two per race

CHICANE | two consecutive turns in opposite directions

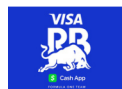
DRS | drag reduction system, opens flap on the rear wing increasing aerodynamic performance and speed, available on select straights

RACE DIRECTOR | in charge of race procedures, track safety, safety cars

SAFETY CAR | in case of racing incident, no over taking, cars reduce speed and bunch up behind the safety car

STEWARDS | referees, investigate racing incidents and give out penalties

VIRTUAL SAFETY CAR | in case of racing incident, no over taking, cars slow to safe speed, maintain time to each other
