Formula E aims to promote and advance sustainability through electric racing. Tracks are temporarily set up in city centres, bringing the action to the spectators.

~50% energy from regenerative braking

No more power = not finishing

Higher speeds use more power

Power limits for each session

ATTACK MODE

Additional power deployed after driving through a designated area of the track off the racing line. Must be used twice per race, in 2+6min, 4+4 min, or 6+2 min deployments. Activates the all wheel drive.

ALL WHEEL DRIVE

Engages the front and rear powertrains. Available during duels, race starts and attack mode.

PIT BOOST

After a 30-second pit stop drivers will have an additional 10% of energy for 30-seconds. Must be served between 40% and 60% energy. Only one car per team at a time.

FLAGS



GREEN | safe track, race on



YELLOW | hazard trackside, double for more serious incidents

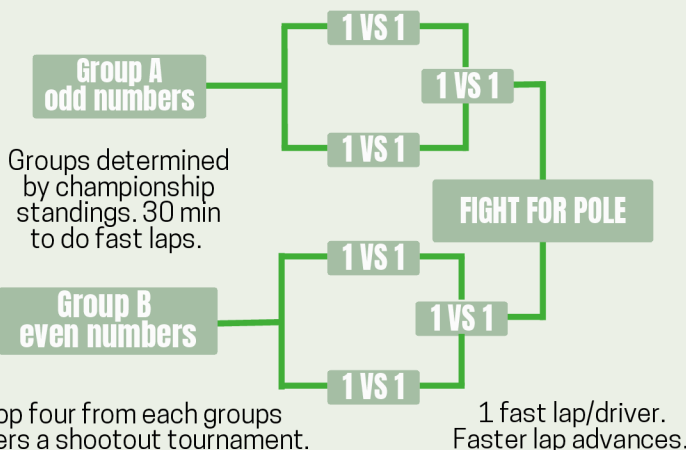


BLUE | slower car must move aside



RED | session suspended, return to pit lane

QUALIFYING



CHICANE |

two consecutive turns in opposite directions

POLE POSITION |

winner of the qualifying tournament, first spot on the starting grid

RACE DIRECTOR |

in charge of race procedures, track safety/safety cars

SAFETY CAR |

in case of racing incident, no overtaking, cars bunch up behind the safety car, laps added at the end of the race to compensate for racing lost

STEWARDS |

referees, investigate racing incidents and give out penalties
